After you accept your offer of admissions, you will receive an email from the college with course registration details. Please complete the required checklist:

Send City Tech *official transcript(s) of all your previously attended colleges and/or post-secondary institutions. Official transcript(s) must:

- contain official seal
- include final semester grades
- provide graduation date, if applicable **
- * Electronic records must be sent directly from attended colleges and/or post-secondary institutions.
- ** If unable to provide an official transcript with graduation date, a sealed letter from the Registrar will be sufficient.

Claim your CUNYfirst Account: Go to <u>CUNYfirst</u> → New User → Enter the required information to claim your CUNYfirst account. Email any questions to the Student Computing Help Desk at <u>studenthelpdesk@citytech.cuny.edu</u> or call 718-260-4900.

ACCEPT YOUR OFFER OF ADMISSION: Login to your <u>CUNYfirst account</u> → Admissions Center → View my Application Station → View Details for "NYC College of Technology" → Confirm offer Acceptance → Pay Commitment Deposit (<u>a commitment fee waiver is available</u>)

Immunization: Upload your required proof of immunization to the <u>Student Document Repository</u>, OR Download the <u>Immunization Form</u>. Once completed, upload to <u>Student Document Repository</u>. If Vaccinated for MMR in the five boroughs, request immunizations records from the Citywide Immunization Registry by visiting <u>My Vaccine Record</u>. <u>Click here</u> for upload instructions.

Residency: If requested, submit the necessary paperwork to receive in-state tuition to the Student Document Repository. Click here for further instructions. The last day to submit your proof of residency for the Spring 2026 semester is May 25, 2026. Should you have any concerns, please email the Office of Residency at residency@citytech.cuny.edu. or call 718-260-5054.

Please complete the required checklist:

- APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID: Visit the <u>City Tech Financial Aid website</u> to learn how to apply for financial aid.
- If you graduated from a foreign high school, take the required Ability to Benefit (ATB) test before February 15, 2026. Once you have registered for classes, schedule an appointment for the ATB by emailing the Office of Academic Testing at testingoffice@citytech.cuny.edu.
- If you are an international student, a student who comes to the United States temporarily to study, visit the Office of International Students Services (OISS) website and complete one of the following that applies to you:
 - International students transferring from another country's institution must complete the <u>I-20</u>
 <u>Request form</u> to obtain an F-1 Visa. Upload the completed forms and supporting documents <u>here</u>,
 then Email the International Student Advisor, Vanessa Villanueva, <u>VVillanueva@citytech.cuny.edu</u>.
 - International students transferring from another U.S institution must complete the <u>City Tech</u> <u>Transfer form</u> and <u>I-20 Request form</u>. Upload the completed forms and supporting documents <u>here</u>, then Email the International Student Advisor, Vanessa Villanueva, <u>VVillanueva@citytech.cuny.edu</u>.
